GENERAL ENTRY REOUIREMENTS

Candidates for the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination are required to obtain the following results for entry into the Year 1 programme:

- Chinese Language and English Language Level 3 or above
- Mathematics, Liberal Studies and one elective subject Level 2 or above*


*Applicants can use at most one relevant Applied Learning subject (ApL) as an elective subject. 'Attained with Distinction (II)' and 'Attained with Distinction (I)' is comparable to level 4 and level 3 respectively. Holders of an Associate Degree or Higher Diploma in a relevant subject obtained from any locally accredited institution, who are also graduate year students or graduates, may apply for entry into Year 2/3^ programmes. ^The minimum entry requirement for Year 3 is a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.5 or above (on a 4.0 scale).



同時,本系強調研究與創作相結合,以培養學生獨立思考和 **創意思維能力**,使他們具備當代意識及世界視野。


